JOB SUMMARY:

Responsible for trimming, patching, preparing, painting and assisting the Painting Lead in completing facial and body coloring for medical training manikin products.

* The ideal candidate would be a fine artist/student with a background in special-effects, painting realistic portraiture and/or other academic artistic color practices.

JOB DUTIES:

- Wash, trim, patch, and prepare various silicone manikin parts.
- Airbrush tinted silicone following paint guides to match established color schemes.
- Availability to work flexible shifts to meet production process timelines.
 - Some additional flexibility in schedule may occasionally be required due to new product development processes and customer requests.
- Assist the Painting Lead in various duties.
- Ensure cleanliness and production level operation of equipment (lighting, airbrush) by completing preventive maintenance requirements, following manufacturer's instructions, troubleshooting malfunctions, calling for repairs, and maintaining consumable inventories.
- Adhere to production schedules and NPD requests for support in concert with Painting Lead.
- Other related tasks as assigned.

ACCOUNTABILITIES:

Preparing and painting manikins following specified processes and guides for consistent and reproducible production of identically painted realistic manikin skins and tissues.
